



**2010 ICSA Women's Semifinal
and National Championships**
Hosted by UW Madison Sailing Team and

1. Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing including US Sailing Prescriptions 2009-2012, the current ICSA Procedural Rules, the Collegiate Class Dinghy Rules, the General Conditions for ICSA Championships, the Conditions for the Women's Dinghy Championship, and this Notice of Race, except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions.
2. Boats: The event will be held in Collegiate 420s as provided by the host with sails donated by North Sails.
3. Eligibility: All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. All entrants must have qualified from their respective conference championship according to the Conditions for the Women's Dinghy Championship.
4. Fees: The entry fee is \$150 per team and includes banquet tickets for up to 6 competitors. Additional banquet tickets are available for \$30 a ticket. It is highly encouraged that you reserve extra banquet tickets in advance of the event at the event website to avoid a potential shortage of tickets.

Amendment 4: The Women's Semi-Final Round will end at (no race started after) noon on Day Two or 8 races in each division WHICHEVER IS LATER. At the conclusion of Semi Final, teams will be given 45 minutes of practice prior to Warning for First Race of Finals.

6. Advanced Registration: Teams shall register as soon as possible after their conference championship by completing the entry form on the regatta website and emailing it to ceporter@wisc.edu
7. Housing: Teams are responsible for housing and reservations. Information about local hotels and dorm housing is available at the event website.
8. Sailing Instructions: Will be available at registration
9. Transportation: Madison Airport (MSN) is the closest airport. Taxis to and from the airport are less than \$20 each way. Milwaukee (MKE) and Chicago O'Hare (ORD) both have busses that serve the sailing site. Most regular visitors and residents of Madison do not use automobiles for transportation. All activities are within a reasonable walking distance. Parking is available within a 5 blocks of the sailing site in public parking garages for roughly \$10 a day. Active loading and unloading is allowed at the sailing site. Check the regatta website for more information.
10. Meals: Except for banquets and post racing events, all meals are the responsibility of the competitors.
